## 1 Thessalonians Chapter 3 -- Listener Notes

  - Ignore it
  - Determine what the Greek word means
  - See what it is there for
  - Pray for your pastor
  - Memorize the passage
- Paul wanted to finish laying the groundwork of Christian faith for them so that they would not be \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ from the truth.
