3.	What was it that caused John to cry? ☐ The scroll was too beautiful to open ☐ He was not allowed to see what was in the scroll ☐ He got something in his eye ☐ No one was found worthy to open the scroll
4.	Where did the expression, "Lion of the tribe of Judah" come from?
5.	What do you think is the significance of the Lamb being described as "a little lambkin" (<i>arnion</i>) throughout the Book of Revelation? (There is no right or wrong answer to this question.)
6.	What do the seven horns of the lambkin represent?
